## Accommodations and modifications



### What are accommodations and modifications?

#### Accommodations

Using different strategies for **how** students complete the same task as others.

#### Example:

Using headphones during a writing task to **accommodate** for a student's sensitivity to sound.

#### Modifications




Changing the **what** or expectation of a task. This could be changing the task, goal, or environment

#### Example:

Completing writing tasks in a separate room to **modify** the environment for a student with noise sensitivity.

### What types of supports may be required?

People may require a variety of different supports within the classroom. This will depend on their individual needs and should be discussed with their family and supports.

-  movement and sensory regulation supports
-  communication supports
-  organisation and executive functioning supports
